Rutgers University Undergraduate and Graduate Food Science Student Update

With the arrival of spring, we find ourselves at the threshold of another exciting chapter in our academic journey. As we gather our books, don our lab coats, and prepare our minds for the challenges ahead, we are filled with a sense of purpose and determination to make the most of this spring semester.

At the start of the semester, the Rutgers Food Science Graduate Student Association (GSA) warmly welcomed students and faculty members with a delightful afternoon tea party, celebrating the Chinese New Year. More than 40 attendees from various countries came together to savor an array of delicious Asian snacks and beverages, sharing insights from their diverse cultural backgrounds, and fostering a sense of camaraderie and connection within the community. We believe that diversity enriches our academic community, supports a vibrant exchange of ideas, and enhances our collective learning experience.

The most anticipated event of the year, Student Night, happened on February 22 at the New Jersey Institute for Food, Nutrition & Health at Rutgers University. With over 40 students and 50 industry professionals participating in this event, the Student Night was a prime networking event and celebration that brought together students, professionals, and industry experts, co-hosted by Rutgers GSA and NY/CNJIFT. From 4:00 to 6:00 PM, attendees seized the opportunity to engage in meaningful conversations and establish lasting relationships. The event also featured a mini-career fair, attracting renowned companies such as Campbell's, Ingredion, Kerry, and Robertet, who also generously donated swag items for students. Additionally, Mondelēz and Citromax, though unable to attend, contributed to the event's success. Meanwhile, eight undergraduate and graduate students showcased their research projects through captivating poster presentations, providing a glimpse into the innovative endeavors shaping the future of food science. This interactive platform enabled students to engage with a wider audience, honing their presentation and communication skills.

Following the networking session, attendees were treated to an enlightening panel discussion titled "Navigating the Path Ahead: Academia vs. Industry." Moderated by the Department Chair Dr. Don Schaffner, the panel featured distinguished experts: Ms. Tamanna Ramesh, Founder of Spark Career Services; Dr. Beverly Tepper, Rutgers Food Science Graduate Program Director; and Rutgers Alumnus Dr. Sarah (Waxman) Tully, Food Applications Innovation Lead at Ingredion. Together, they delved into the nuances of various career paths within the food science industry, offering valuable insights into the pros and cons of graduate school, strategies for achieving dream jobs, and predictions on how rapidly evolving technologies will impact the role of food scientists. The event also presented scholarships to six Rutgers students and two Montclair students. Of particular significance, two of these scholarships were awarded in memory of former NYIFT members, Clare Dus and Ruth Selle (both passed away within the past year). This event was heralded as a resounding success, effectively bridging the gap between students and industry professionals while elevating the visibility and recognition of both IFT and Rutgers University.

In April, we are gearing up for an exciting presence at Suppliers Day, featuring an Alumni reunion. All poster presenters from Student Night will be there to showcase students' work once again.
